



# Sportsfishing in Ål

## General information

- Fishing cards can be obtained at the Tourist Information, sports stores, Statoil station and several accommodation places. Some of the zones has an own self service box for fishing cards.
- Fishing seasons vary so see the spesifications on the fishing cards or in this brochure. All waters have trout. In zones 3 and 32 you can also find gwyniad, and in zones 33, 15 and 16 there is char.
- Hallindalselva is regulated so you may experience quick change in the water level.
- Dogs must be kept in a leash at all times due to leashing regulations.
- Minnow in the fish rivers and waters are a major damage to the fish waters so do follow these restrictions: Never use live bait and never take a fish from one water and release in a different one.
- Remember that it is not allowed to walk on cultivated land.
- If you are not familiar with the terrain/area we recommend you to buy a proper map, as "Reineskarvet 1:50 000" "Veståsen/Sangefjell 1:50 000", "Ål 1616 III", "Geilo 1516 II" and "Djup 1516 IV". Other maps may also cover the fishing areas.

## Information about all fishing zones in Ål

### The members of "Stangfiske i Ål":

**2 Opsjø:** Opsjø has borders to the football stadium and Rv 7 (highway) on the northside. Do not walk on cultivated land.

**3 Veståsen:** Presttjern: Walking path from Dokki (sign). Øyetjern & Butjærne: Walking path from Bosset or Svanset. Hesttjern & Trolltjern: Road along the powerline, entrance from east and west. Hesttjern has a small quay especially made for wheelchair users.

**4 Føtjerni:** Drive the mountain road to Åsetno on the Votndalsåsen. Follow the signs.

**5 Svartetjern:** Drive the mountain road from Liatoppen towards Åsetno. Follow the signs.

**6 Votna:** Drive the road 244 towards Vats. Several paths are marked from the road to the river.

**7 Eitrestølen Sameige:** Drive the road 244 towards Leveld. Take off at the sign towards Hemsedal until you find the crossing to Reine and Eitrestølen.

**8 Rødungstølen Sameige:** Drive the road 244 to Bergsjøområdet and Rødungstøl Høyfjellshotell.

**9 Bergsjøstølen Sameige:** Drive the road 244 to Bergsjøområdet and Bergsjøstølen.

**10 Hesthovdstølen Sameige:** Same as zones 8 & 9, or follow the signs in Vats towards Langegard and Sirestølen parking.

**11 Fødalen Statsalmenning:** Follow road 244 towards Bergsjøområdet, continue the road to Toviken. From the parking by Mjølga/Toviken it is 1,5 – 3 hours walk.

**12 Toviken:** Same as zone 11 except from the walk.

**13 Auståsen – Vats:** Same as zone 9. Paths from Bergsjø and Bergsjøstølen.

**14 Lya:** From the mountain road on Votndalsåsen and Opheimsåsen

**15 Rødungen nord, Bergsjøområdet:** Same as zone 8.

**16: Rødungen sør, Sangefjell:** Take Rv 7 (highway) to Kleivi, continue over the bridge and follow the road to Sangefjell.  
*Self service box for fishing cards by a stone quarry at Tullestølen.*

**17 Lauvdalen:** Drive to Leveld, follow the signs towards Hemsedal until you pass Lauvdalen.  
*Self service box for fishing cards on the road a bit past Lauvdalen. Fishing allowed from 20th June – 19th Sept.*

**30/31/32 Torpo/Opheimsåsen:** Take Rv 7 (highway) to Torpo and then follow the signs to Opheim. The path signs to the fishingwaters are shaped as a fish. *Self service box for fishing cards by the toll road. Fishing allowed from the ice disappears to 15th Sept.*

#### Other zones in Ål:

**33 Øvre Vatsfjorden:** Take road 244 to Vats. Only allowed to fish west of the red/white pole.  
*Self service box for fishing cards on the house wall on the house opposite Hallingdal Natur og Miljøseniter i Vats. Fishing allowed all year around.*

**34 Søre Reine:** Same as zone 7 and follow the signs to Reine.  
*Self service box for fishing cards on the summer pasture farm at Reine. Fishing allowed between 20th June - 19th Sept.*
